
Concert & Potluck

After setting up for the last breakfast, Mary Klein

was setting up for the Soul Core Exercise Rosary in the hall. I had not gone to this event in the past. Lanna and I decided to join.

In this class you meditate on the rosary while doing physical movements, more like stretching with the arms and legs. Each decade had their respective exercise and reading Different parts of the rosary you would do arm raising, other times you would sit and raise your legs one at a time. You don't say the rosary and Mary does the readings that allow you to meditate on the various parts. At first, this was not expected.

What I found was I had time to think or meditate on the readings. Since everybody is different, you do the exercises that you can do comfortably and if you have difficulty with one exercise you don't do it—you exercise at your own ability. Mary is not a Marine Corp drill sergeant, so do what you can with no judgement. If you can't do something, you don't have to do it. I had both knees replaced so pulling the knee back was one I did not do. Overall, it was a good experience and I will do it again. The class is a great way to make your body move and have a spiritual experience with our Blessed Mother.

The National Shrine application meeting was scheduled in Gaylord last week and was cancelled due to weather. So it is still in a holding pattern for the moment. The Restoration Committee had a meeting on the 17th and so that will have to be reported on later.

The last breakfast was a tremendous success and was attended by 64 people.
