

⇒ **Reconciliation for Advent will be these same days after Mass.**

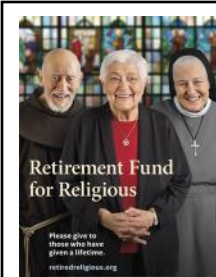
