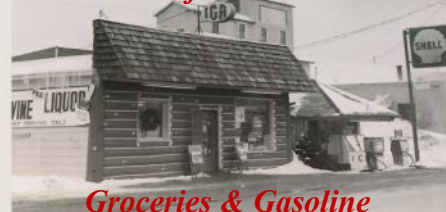

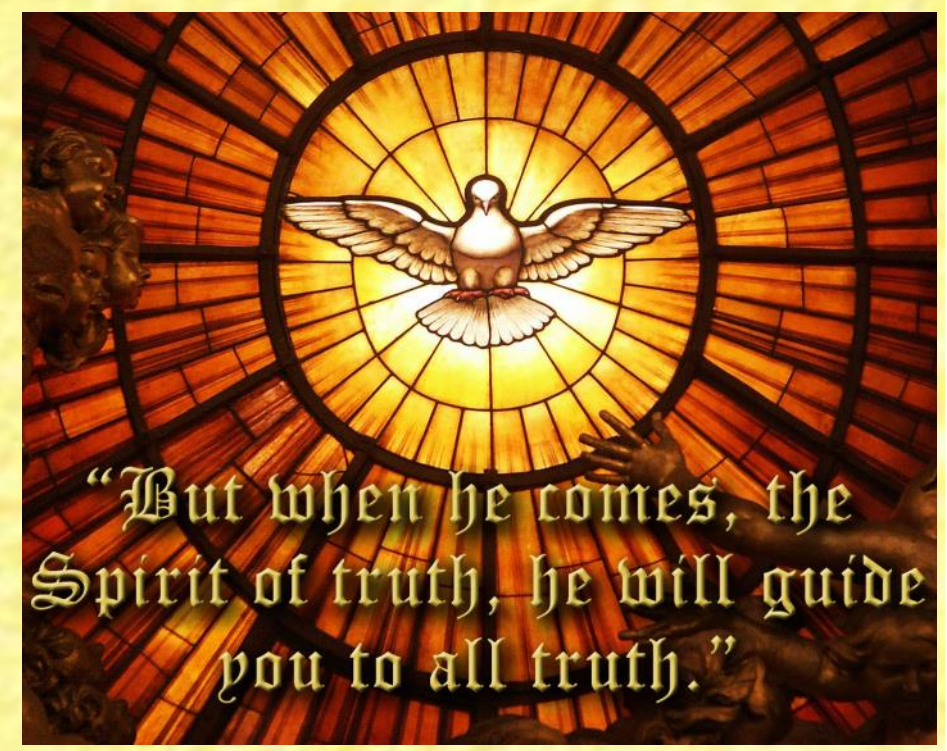

This is another weekend to celebrate. First, we have Pentecost Sunday which is the 50th day after Easter.

Second, is the May Crowning of our Mother Mary. This year we honor the apparition of Our Lady of Fatima.

Finally, we celebrate those of our parish who received their first Holy Communion and Confirmation.

Pentecost is when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples with sounds of wind and tongues of fire. The disciples were then sent out by the Holy Spirit to spread the word of God to all peoples.

We have **\$43,575.69** towards this year's project—work began this week on the ponds, the waterfalls, and the application of a sealant to the entire structure.

The apparition of Our Lady of Fatima is when she appeared to 3 youngsters in Portugal in 1917. Portugal had experienced a civil war, whereby, the new government was opposed to all religious practices.

Our Mother Mary directed these children to pray for an end to the Great War of World War I and bring the people back to God. There was the "Miracle of the Sun" where the sun danced in the sky and many were healed.
