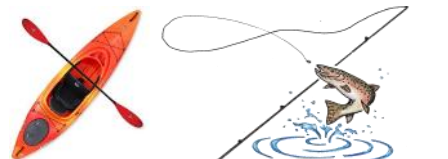

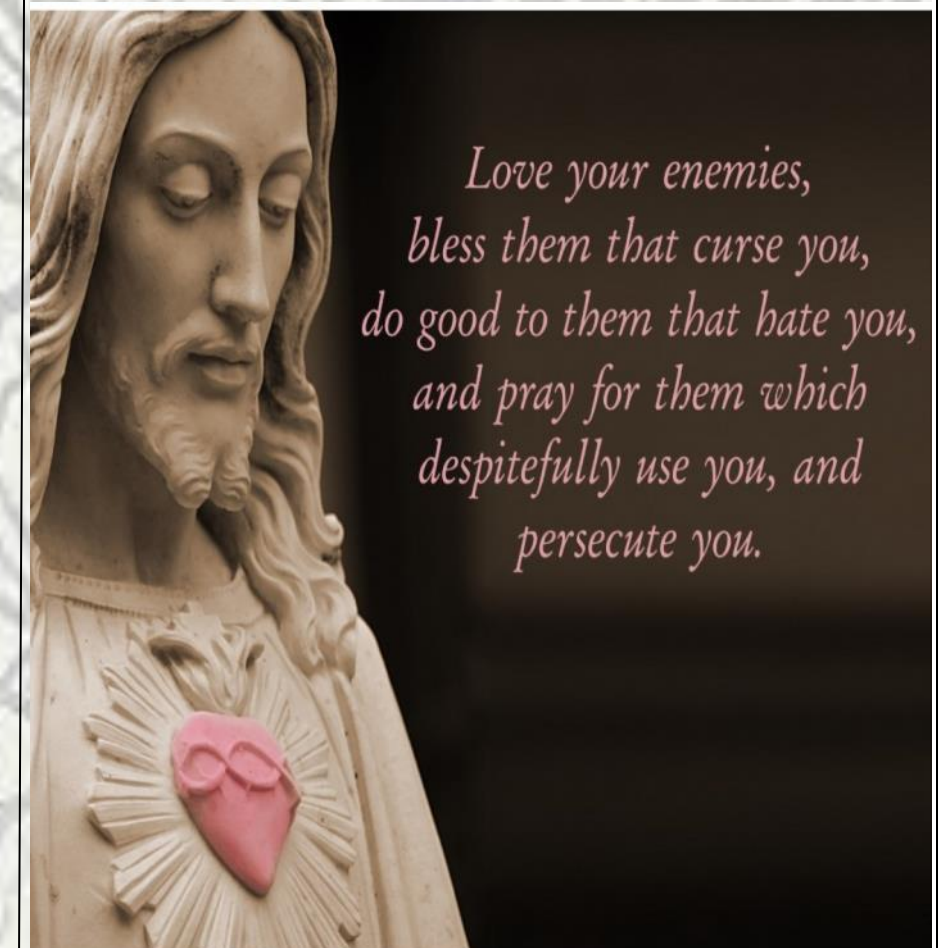

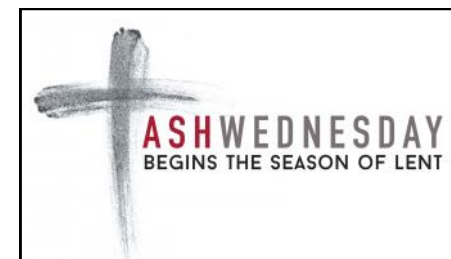
Ash Wednesday
Day of Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday is March 2nd. Mass will be at 9:00 am that day with distribution of ashes only at 6:00 pm.

Ash Wednesday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller portions that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Catholics from age 14 onwards.

SHRINE CORNER

The Restoration meeting did not answer all the questions about cost. Cost for the Idaho Quartz stone has gone up considerably. The additional cost is due to transportation costs that have skyrocketed for all products, not just stone. To be delivered to the Shrine from the company and dropped at the site is \$795/ton, and we need 30 tons plus 30% for cuts, broken pieces and other issues that may develop. Some research into the stone from the Michigan Aggregate Association out of Lansing said this is the very best, hard, dense and long-lasting flat surface stone available for the patio.

Additional questions arose, but before decisions were made on stone, the meeting was turned over to the structure. The bid proposed was from last year where the Shrine was broken into a top half and a bottom half. The bid for the lower half was \$100,000. Remember the bid from last year for the top half was \$135,000 and it was completed for \$73,796, a little over half. In addition, that cost included coming down the top of both ends, which was not included in the bid, so they actually did more than intended. So, when the bid arrives this year, I expect the bid for the structure to be a lot less than last year's bid.

The patio work lack of a bid was understandable. Meridian does not know what they are dealing with underneath the current patio stones and until the weather breaks and they can open it up, no official bid can be received. Meridian is willing to start in the spring when the weather breaks, hopefully in April. If cold weather arrives during their work and they cannot use the mortar, they will remove several stones from the patio at different locations to look underneath and find out the working conditions. After that is done, an official bid can be made.

Now back to the Idaho Quartz stone. We feel that is the best quality stone for the Shrine and some more inquiries on delivery and how that will work are still necessary. At this time no decision was made on purchasing the stone. If we pick-up, will that reduce costs was another question. TBD.

Statue restoration was discussed and the May 22 date explained. Some of the group did not know that so many statues had been adopted and the money sits in the bank for this part of the restoration. In addition, Mary from the Crucifixion is now paid in full and completes this adoption. We are truly in the very best Parish. Thank YOU! God Bless, Jim L.
