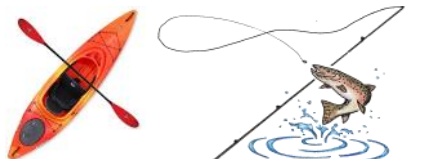



Our Lady of the Woods Shrine (OLWS) website has gone through many enhancements over the past few months.

The front page has two separate icons: One is a green icon that goes to the parish website and the other is an orange icon that takes one to our online giving website.

The parish website includes the weekly bulletins and other pertinent information as shown before including more tour information.

The online giving website allows one to contribute to the parish, the shrine or to acquire a brick paver.

We currently have **\$48,795.77** in our Restoration Account.

Thanks to parishioner Scott Dzienis, the OLWS website now includes a QR code to access a new mobile shrine audio tour. This allows one to have a self-guided tour which includes many separate sound bites.
