St. Hubert

We have \$17,092.62 in our restoration account.

The afternoon of November 3rd is our Funraiser for the Detroit Lion versus Green Bay football game played at Lambeau field.

The festivities start at 4pm and you are welcome to bring your own chair. Ironically, November 3rd is also the feast day of one of our most beloved saints. Yes, it is St. Hubert's feast day. We honor him by the wonderful Bianco Statue from Italy that sits next to the ponds in the front of our shrine. He is also the patron saint of Father Hubert Rakowski, who had the dream of building a shrine in Mio back in 1945.

St. Hubert is the patron saint of hunting, woodsmen, mathematicians and opticians. On a Good Friday, Hubert decided to go hunting rather than attend any church services. While hunting, he came upon a deer, and drew back his arrow to kill the deer, when he saw a crucifix between its antlers. A voice said, *Hubert, if you do not turn yourself towards the Lord, you will surely go to hell.*

Hubert immediately prostrated himself and asked the Lord what should he do. He was told to go see Bishop Lambert and he would instruct him. In 708 AD, Hubert became the first Bishop of Liege.
