

Our Lady of the Woods Shrine (OLWS) was completed on September 27th 1954 and dedicated in front of 4,000 to 5,000 people on September 4th 1955. This Shrine has been a local Marian Shrine since that point in time. Although some efforts were put forth in 2017 to establish OLWS as a National Shrine, it never materialized.

Currently, a new revitalized effort is being made to establish OLWS as a National Shrine. The premise is that more people will visit a National Shrine over a local Marian shrine. Becoming a National Shrine would give people an “increased awareness” of OLWS through a larger audience. The Shrine has always been a place of prayer, a spiritual oasis for people for over 65 years. Advertising and word of mouth has only gotten us so far. Therefore, to reach more people, we need to step up to the National level. The biggest pull for evangelization that St. Mary-Mio has is its Shrine. If we increase the number of pilgrims to OLWS, we bring Our Lady to our visitors, and through her, we bring her Son. OLWS is about spreading the Word of God. Jesus is RISEN. He is alive.
