# **Shrine Corner**

National Shrine

Our Lady of the Woods Shrine (OLWS) was completed on September 27<sup>th</sup> 1954 and dedicated in front of 4,000 to 5,000 people on September 4<sup>th</sup> 1955. This



Shrine has been a local Marian Shrine since that point in time. Although some efforts were put forth in 2017 to establish OLWS as a National Shrine, it never materialized.

Currently, a new revitalized effort is being made to establish OLWS as a National Shrine. The premise is that more people will visit a National Shrine over a local Marian shrine. Becoming a

National Shrine would give people an AUDIO TOUR "increased awareness" of OLWS

through a larger audience. The Shrine has always been a place of prayer, a spiritual oasis for people for over 65 years. Advertising and word of mouth has only gotten us so far. Therefore, to reach more people, we need to step up to the National level. The



biggest pull for evangelization that St. Mary-Mio has is its Shrine. If we increase the number of pilgrims to OLWS, we bring Our Lady to our visitors, and through her, we bring her Son. OLWS is about spreading the Word of God. Jesus is RISEN. He is alive.

To date, we have developed the Mission Statement, established the Purposes and underlying Goals and Objectives. The next step is to identify the necessary Administrative Responsi- DONATE HERE

bilities that are required. The plan is to submit a national shrine application to Bishop Walsh before the end of this year.
