Shrine Corner A Precious Meeting

We have \$24,855.19 in our restoration account.

I had the privilege to

meet Santo Montani from our parish. For those who may not know him, Santo was one of the original construction workers in the building of Our Woods Shrine back in the summer of 1954. His main job was to mix the concrete (not mortar) which was used to adhere the Onaway limestone together.

At this meeting, he gave me some historical information on the Shrine and provided me with photographs and an early brochure of Our Lady of the Woods Shrine. This information was scanned and is available to view upon request.

One area of interest was gathering information on the Crucifixion Cross behind the Parish Hall. I was unaware of any information on the construction of this cross prior to this



meeting. This is the one with steps to the top and is surrounded by the Stations of the Cross, a Statue of Mary and a Statue of the Disciple John, also known as the other disciple. This is not the Steel cross in front near M-72.

Anyway, Santo provided me with a picture dated May 1955, showing a crane at that location presumably there to set the steel cross. Yes, it is a steel cross. I thought it was made of wood but upon my own inspection it is made of steel.

Finally, there is a picture of 5 men standing on top of the completed Shrine in the Parish Hall. Santo is the one furthest on the right.
